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Planting Guide

ROC# 269580

Dig the hole 1.5 times the width & 3"- 6" deeper than the container size. Cut ridges on the sides & bottom of hole with a shovel to avoid root binding.

Prepare soil mix of equal parts native soil and mulch. Add GYPSUM and generous amount of soil mix at the bottom and pack in so once the plant is set in the hole the top of the rootball will be slightly higher than ground level allowing for the soil mix to set.

Take the plant out of container and place in hole (if you see numerous large circling roots on the outside of the root ball gently loosen up roots with fingers.)

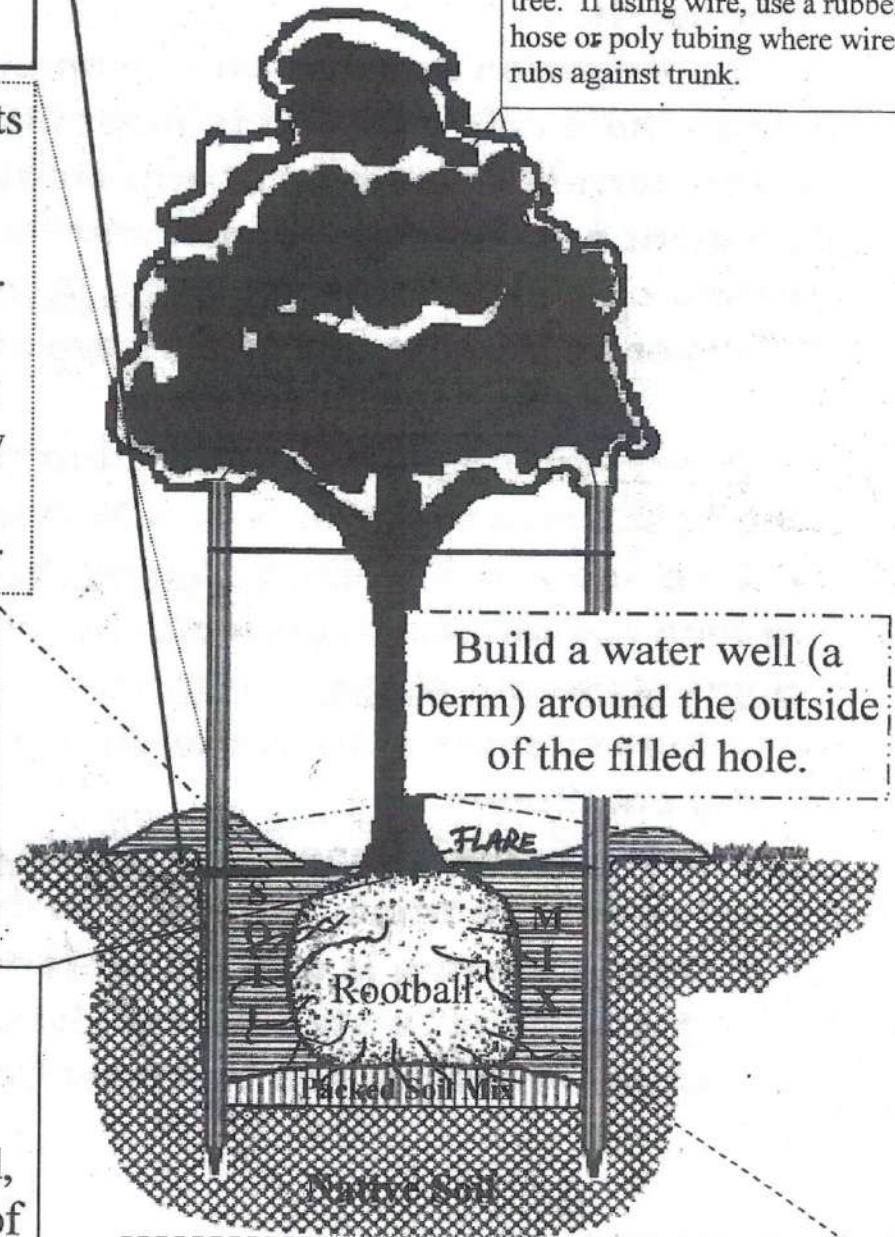
For ball and burlap DO NOT remove burlap (or wire basket, if included) & gently place in hole. Once completely planted, remove twine holding the top of burlap to the bottom of the tree trunk.

For Trees: stake with lodge poles. Do not drive into rootball but through soil mix & into native soil. Tie tree tape or wire to poles & wrap around tree. If using wire, use a rubber hose or poly tubing where wire rubs against trunk.



Build a water well (a berm) around the outside of the filled hole.

Fill & pack in soil mix, careful not to damage rootball with excessive force.
